Following the submission of your Local Area Agreement revision proposal, I am writing to confirm that the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government has approved the proposal under section 112 of the Local Government & Public Involvement in Health Act 2007. Please find attached formal notice of approval of your LAA revision proposal. I am also pleased to include a copy of the revised LAA. This is confirmation of the local improvement targets designated by the Secretary of State.

The LAA is the agreement between all those who have an interest in improving services and the quality of life for local people. Formal approval of the revision proposal now signals central government's commitment to the deal whilst also marking the formal end of the refresh process. With this approval the "duty to have regard" to the targets as revised now applies both to your authority and to all partner authorities to whom the particular LAA targets relate. I would like to add my personal thanks for the commitment and support demonstrated by you and your officials throughout the Worcestershire partnership. The discussions that have taken place on the economic indicators have proved really productive, and I am delighted that we reached a good outcome. I also hope the lighter touch approach to refresh this year proved welcome. I would be grateful if you could pass on my thanks to your team and partners in Worcestershire.
